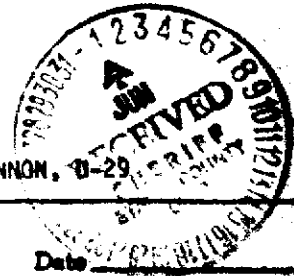

On this date the reporting officer telephoned SGT. GURLEY, the arresting officer. SGT. GURLEY indicated that he arrested HUNTER for CARRYING A CONCEALED WEAPON (the previously mentioned firearm) and upon inquiring through NCIC, learned that it was stolen. SGT. GURLEY indicated that the gun is currently being held as evidence in his case, and he would notify the officer when it is okay to be released. After conversing with SGT. GURLEY, there appeared to be no open obvious connection between HUNTER and the burglary at JOHN'S SPORTING GOODS.

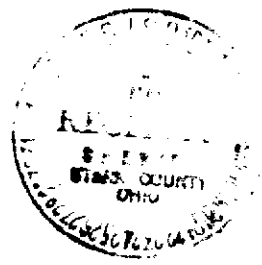

come to Massillon. At Massillon Police Headquarters DETECTIVE WILSON told the officer he had received information where some of the guns could be bought. According to DETECTIVE WILSON, the seller was identified as SAUNDERS. DETECTIVE WILSON, along with undercover ATF Agent CARTER and other Agents had arranged to buy the guns from SAUNDERS in the 1600 bk of East Tuscarawas Street in Canton. The reporting officer, AGENT TOM SHYDER and Canton SERGEANT RICK GHRISS were together in the immediate area monitoring the transaction. The pair met on East Tuscarawas St. and then drove seperately to the parking lot of the Mojave Bar on 8th St NE where AGENT CARTER was sold the 11 guns. ATF AGENTS are currently investigating another connection in the Akron area therefor no action against SAUNDERS is going to be taken immediately. The guns were retained by ATF pending the outcome of this case. The officer will be notified when this matter may be presented to the prosecutor for Grand Jury action.
