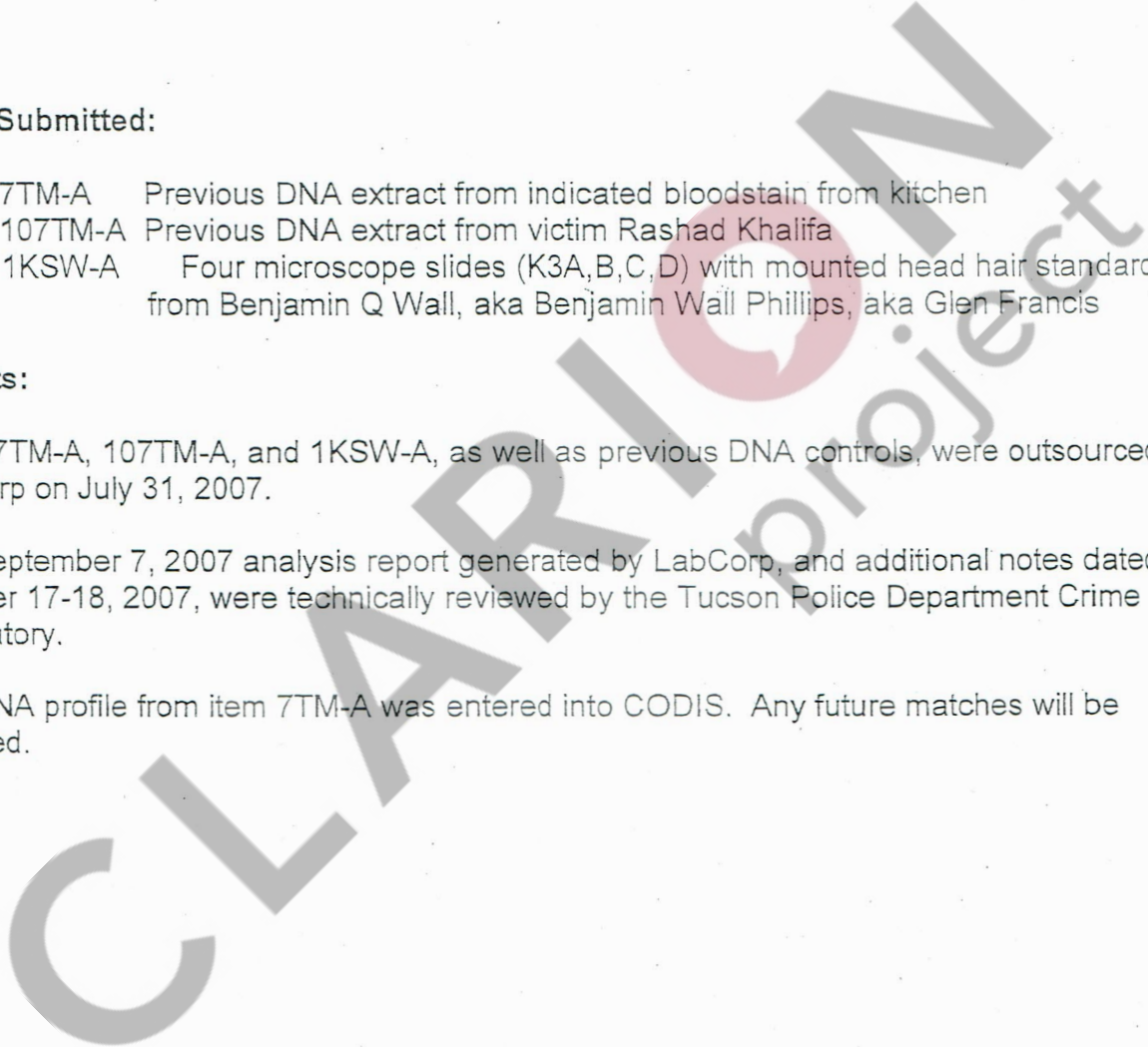
- 7TM-A Previous DNA extract from indicated bloodstain from kitchen
- 107TM-A Previous DNA extract from victim Rashad Khalifa
- 1KSW-A Four microscope slides (K3A,B,C,D) with mounted head hair standards from Benjamin Q Wall, aka Benjamin Wall Phillips, aka Glen Francis

Results:

Items 7TM-A, 107TM-A, and 1KSW-A, as well as previous DNA controls, were outsourced to LabCorp on July 31, 2007.

The September 7, 2007 analysis report generated by LabCorp, and additional notes dated October 17-18, 2007, were technically reviewed by the Tucson Police Department Crime Laboratory.

The DNA profile from item 7TM-A was entered into CODIS. Any future matches will be reported.

Items Submitted:

- 1FBI-A Plucked and combed head hair samples from Leland Walker, also fingerprint card - not analyzed
- 2-LAB 9TM-1 Stain from dish towel
- 9TM Dish towel
- 16TM-A Metal gallon can "Parks Xylene/Xylo" – handle swabbed with 2 swabs
- 102TM Victim Khalifa leather coat
- 103TM Victim Khalifa shirt
- 104TM Victim Khalifa pants
- 107TM Victim Khalifa autopsy samples, including hair standards and left/right fingernail cuts - 2 swabs made from rinse of nail cuts (each)


1FBI, 105TM, 106TM – Received; not analyzed

Results:

Testing indicated bloodstains on items 9TM, 102TM, 103TM, 104TM, and 107TM (nail cuts). No blood was found on item 16TM-A. Hairs and/or fibers were collected from items 102TM and 103TM and repackaged with the evidence.

The following samples were outsourced to LabCorp for DNA analysis on June 26, 2008 (FedEx 856934189049), and extracts again on August 26, 08 (FedEx 862318363746) for additional typing on item 102TM-2: 1FBI-A (plucked head hairs), 9TM-1 (from 2-LAB), 9TM-3, 16TM-A swabs, 102TM (3 stains), 103TM (3 stains), 104TM (5 stains), 107TM (swabs from rinse of left and right nail cuts).

The September 15, 2008 DNA analysis report generated by LabCorp was technically reviewed by the Tucson Police Department Crime Laboratory.


