

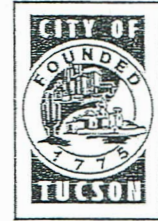

The known impression of the left thumb of Mr. Glen C. Francis has been compared to the known left thumb impression of Mr. Joseph Q. Wall. It has been determined that Mr. Francis and Mr. Wall are the same individual.

Additional Statement:

Please refer to previous comparison reports referencing the above-listed subjects and Mr. Joseph Q. Wall.

Known foot impressions of all subjects (except for Mr. Khalifa) will need to be provided in order to compare Item 1BG, Lift #2A to those subjects.

Item 1BG does not contain AZAFIS quality impressions; therefore, no search can be conducted.

There are no remaining unidentified impressions of AZAFIS quality in Item 1GO; therefore, no search can be conducted.

All AZAFIS quality impressions from Item 1JL have been searched, and no additional identifications have been made at this time.

This report concerns the examination of the above-listed Item(s) only. Due to ongoing investigations and evidence processing, there is a potential for additional latents to be generated in the future. If that does occur, and it becomes necessary to perform an examination of those items (latents), another submission must be requested at that time.

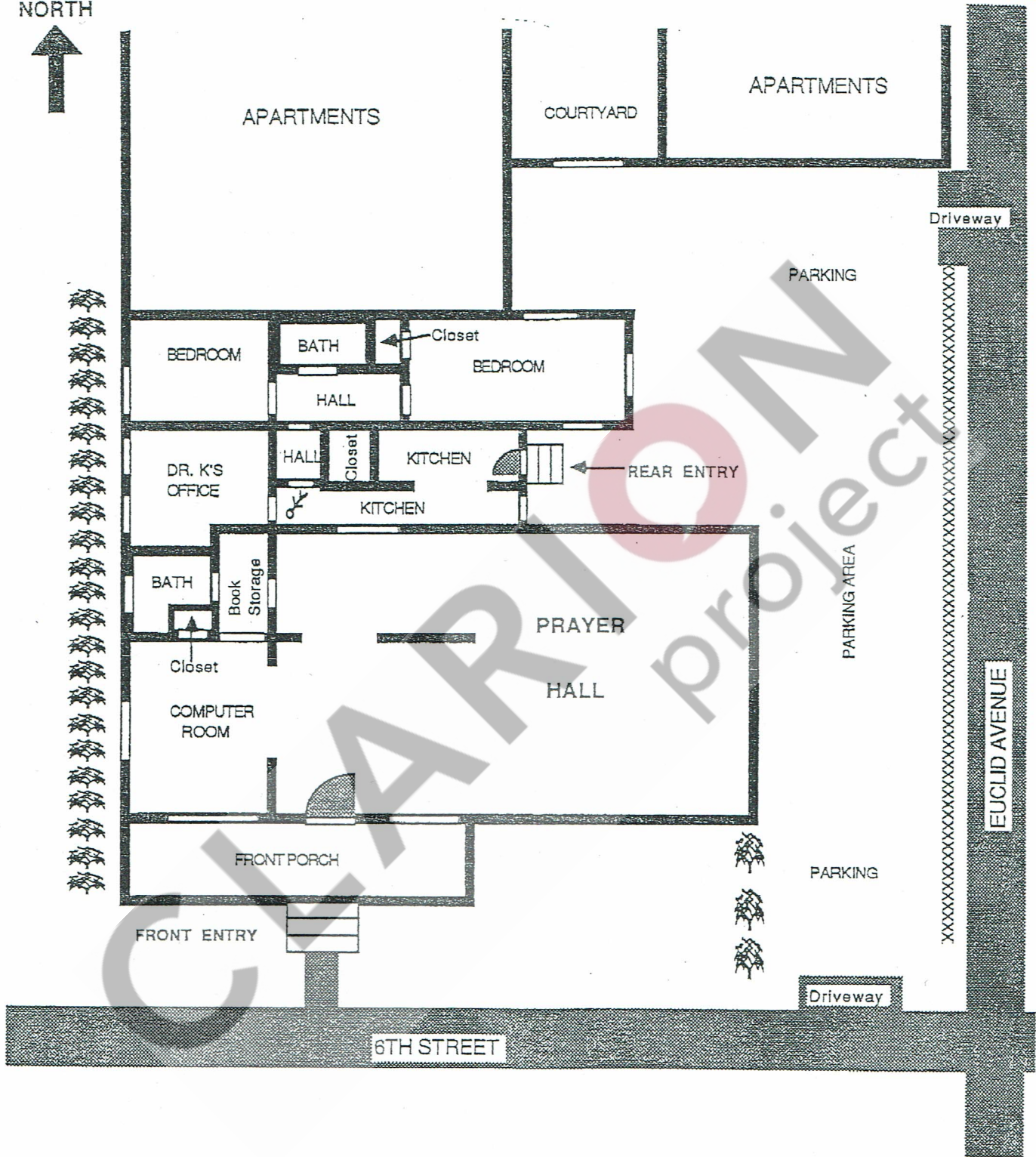

Results:

Previous testing indicated bloodstains on items 4TM, 7TM-A & B, 9TM-1, 10TM-1, 11TM-3, and 105TM-1 (see report dated 3-5-1990). These stains, as well as the victim Khalifa's bloodstain standard (107TM-A), were outsourced to LabCorp for DNA analysis on July 20, 2006. The February 5, 2007 DNA analysis report generated by LabCorp was technically reviewed by the Tucson Police Department Crime Laboratory. The partial, male DNA profile resolved from the mixture from item 7TM-A (indicated bloodstain from edge of kitchen sink counter) was entered into the Arizona DNA database. If additional standards were submitted, further comparison could be done.

No blood was found on items 8TM-B or 47TM.
